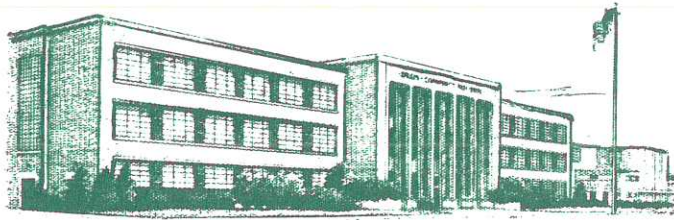

Dear SCHS Families:

I hope this message finds you and your families safe and well and enjoying some semblance of summer. I want to thank the dedication of the individuals that have been working since spring on our Return to Learn plan. While it has at times been overwhelming, it has also reinforced the Margaret Mead quote, "Never doubt that a small group of thoughtful, committed citizens can change the world. Indeed, it is the only thing that ever has."

The Board Education approved the SCHS Return to Learn plan on July 20. The Board approved a Blended Remote Model (hybrid) that will have approximately 50% of the students in-person while the other 50% of students remote into the class at the assigned class period.

On-line registration will open on Thursday, July 23. There will be more information sent out later this week. During registration, families will have the option to select in-person learning, currently running at 50% capacity, or total remote learning for the 1st grading period. Families may move to remote learning at any point, but must remain in remote learning for the duration of the 1st quarter.

There will be no iPad fee or partnership hours required for the 2020-21 school year. Any hours that are accrued will be applied to the following school year and may be turned in at any time.

The first student attendance day will be Thursday, August 20 for students with last name A-K and Friday, August 21 for students with last name L-Z. There is still much work to do before then, but I am confident that as we work in partnership, we can accomplish great things....together.
