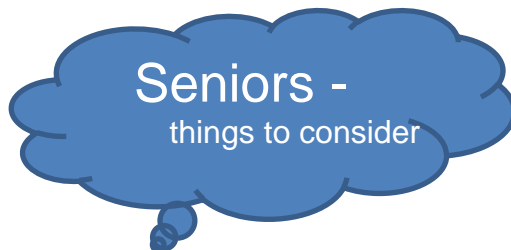
New Students moving into the district

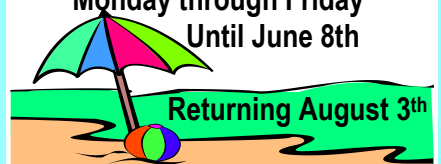
