PSAT/NMSQT

The PSAT/NMSQT is an optional test given to college bound juniors. It is recommended that junior students take the test to help prepare them for the SAT that will be given to all Juniors on Tuesday, April 10, 2018. Students who score in the top 10% in the nation on the PSAT/NMSQT may qualify for the National Merit Scholars Program. There may be some private scholarships that require a PSAT score in order to apply (Union Pacific R.R. for employee's children is one we know about).

The PSAT/NMSQT will be given on **Wednesday, October 11, 2017**. Students taking the test will be responsible for making arrangements ahead of time with their classroom teachers for any work that will be missed. The test will begin at **7:40** in the cafeteria. The fee to take the test is \$15.00.

Students should listen for announcements in late September to know when to sign up and pay in Student Services.
